

## Instructions for using the Wageningen drift calculator

The procedure for using the Wageningen drift calculator (WDC) for various types of applications – in effect from 1 January 2022 – is shown schematically below. Applications submitted before and after this date therefore follow different procedures. For the substantive aspects of the implementation, please refer to the Evaluation Manuals.

### **Situation: applications submitted before 2022<sup>1</sup>; decision on or after 1 January 2022.**

<b>New applications (NL = ZRMS or CMS; NLWERG).</b>	If the WDC is submitted by the applicant (for all aspects of drift), it is used only in the assessment <sup>2</sup> .	For legal instructions for use (WGs) that are established from 01-01-2022, only DRT classes are permitted. Effective immediately, we therefore request that clients submit WGs with only DRT classes on the label and use these for aspects to be assessed. New WGs for decisions on previously submitted applications that are signed from 1 January 2022 will be checked for this and – if necessary – modified by the Ctgb	Where relevant <sup>3</sup> , the initial situation (baseline) will also be modified.
<b>Applications for extended authorisation or amended authorisation (NLWG, ZWTG, NLWTG, NLWERGU) – Extension or amendment relates to drift.</b>	The WDC will only be used in the assessment if submitted by the applicant (for all aspects of drift to be assessed).	For legal instructions for use (WGs) that are established from 01-01-2022, only DRT classes are permitted. New WGs for decisions on previously submitted applications that are signed from 1 January 2022 will be checked for this and – if necessary – will be modified by the Ctgb.	Where relevant for the amendment: modified initial situation (baseline) is used.  Where not relevant for the amendment: Initial situation (not actively modified) is used.
<b>Applications for extended authorisation or amended authorisation (NLWG, ZWTG, NLWTG, NLWERGU) – Extension or amendment does not relate to drift.</b>	There is no assessment for the drift component; the risk assessment can remain unchanged.	For all WGs that are established from 1 January 2022, only DRT classes are permitted. New WGs for decisions on previously submitted applications that are signed from 1 January 2022 will be checked for this and – if necessary – will be modified by the Ctgb.	Not relevant for amendment: Initial situation (not actively modified) is used.

<sup>1</sup> This includes applications that are pending and those that will be submitted until 01-01-2022.

<sup>2</sup> In this context, drift includes exposure (or possible exposure) via drift of Aquatic Organisms, Non-target Arthropods and Non-target Plants.

<sup>3</sup> If woody soft fruit, hops, nuts and/or other types of fruit are included in the application and exposure via drift (lateral and upward spraying) applies.

<p><b>NLKUG – Requested crops fall within the Risk Envelope for the drift component.</b></p>	<p>There is no assessment for the drift component; the risk assessment can remain unchanged.</p>	<p>There is no assessment for the drift component; the drift-related measures on the WG do not change. Consequently, the retention of individual measures on the WG – in cases where this is the only possibility – cannot be ruled out.</p>	<p>Where relevant for the requested crop or crops: the modified initial situation is used for the requested – minor – crops when determining the risk envelope for the assessment.</p> <p>Where not relevant for the requested crop or crops: The existing authorisation is not actively modified.</p>
<p><b>NLKUG – Requested crops do not fall within Risk Envelope for the aspect of drift.</b></p>	<p>In the case of a valid assessment framework from before 1 January 2022, we only use the WDC in the assessment if it has been submitted by the applicant (for all aspects of drift).</p> <p>The WDC will be used if the assessment framework is valid after 1 January 2022.</p>	<p>In case of a valid assessment framework from before 1 January 2022, the inclusion of individual measures in the WG – if this is the only possibility – cannot be ruled out.</p> <p>In case of an valid assessment framework from after 01-01-2022, only DRT classes are permitted.</p>	<p>Where relevant for the requested crop or crops: the modified initial situation is used for the requested – minor – crops when determining the risk envelope for the assessment.</p> <p>Where not relevant for the requested crop or crops: The existing authorisation is not actively modified.</p>

The authorisation will not be modified for administrative changes (NLWATG, WYG).
